Irish Beach Water District Resolution 93-5 requires that all septic tanks in the Irish Beach Water District be inspected and pumped, if necessary, every five years by a registered sanitarian or a qualified septic tank operator. This resolution was passed to comply with California Regional Water Quality Control Board Order Number 93-10.
